Keynote: Sarah Bessey

Sarah Bessey is the editor of the *New York Times* bestselling book *A Rhythm of Prayer*. She is also the author of three popular and critically acclaimed books: *Miracles and Other Reasonable Things*; *Out of Sorts: Making Peace with an Evolving Faith*; and *Jesus Feminist*. Sarah co-leads Evolving Faith, a conference and community for wanderers and wonderers and she serves as president of the board for Heartline Ministries in Haiti. She lives in Calgary, Alberta with her husband and their 4 children.

Preacher: Natarsha Sanders

Natarsha Sanders is a preacher, writer and educator who centers her work on the intersections between wholeness, education, and Biblical justice. Through her teaching and preaching she uses antiracist education to counter exclusionist systems.

For 11 years, Natarsha worked as an educator in the state of North Carolina and three years as a district administrator. She has led staff training on racial identity and served as camp chaplain for John Knox Ranch in Fischer, Texas, and served as the keynote speaker for the Mo-Ranch Presbyterian Assembly's Multicultural Youth Conference in Hunt, Texas.

Natarsha serves on the Network for Dismantling Racism in the Synod of the Sun and helped produce the PCUSA Week of Action in August 2021. Natarsha holds a BA from Hollins University, an MA in Education from North Carolina Central University, and is pursuing a Doctor of Educational Ministry from Columbia Theological Seminary. She resides in Texas with her spouse of 18 years, Lorenzo aka Buddy.
