One Great Hour of Sharing

What are Presbyterians doing about the humanitarian crises emanating from Ukraine? How can we join in? As violence in Ukraine continues, numbers of people being displaced and fleeing the country increases by the day. As of March 30, around 10.5 million people – more than a quarter of the Ukrainian population – have been forcibly displaced by the ongoing military offensive. Over 2.3 million people are seeking refuge in Poland alone. People on the move, predominantly women and children, face growing risks of exploitation and abuse, gender-based violence and human trafficking. And in the midst of the chaos, there are sibling churches and ecumenical partners already providing assistance with basic items for survival. First priority of PC(USA) Presbyterian Disaster Assistance is to provide funding to these partners with boots on the ground. While the scale of this crisis is new, receiving refugees from Ukraine and other countries in Central and Eastern Europe is not, which means they have trusted, established partners with the knowledge and expertise to carry out this important work to people in critical need.

Please give to the "<u>One Great Hour of Sharing</u>" special offering on Easter Sunday to enable Presbyterian Disaster Assistance to respond directly to this existential threat. Likewise, in this season of Lent, pray for our siblings in Ukraine. Pray for peace. And pray that all of us will remember that we are the Church, together.
