This will be an opportunity for First Presbyterian members to interact with Oasis staff, volunteers, and board members, as well as touring the property and facilities, and seeing the preparations that have begun for the new pavilion, which is being funded by FPC. Coffee, juice, donuts, and bagels will be served at 9:00, as well as lunch around noon. Projects should be completed within 2-3 hours, and all be finished by mid-afternoon. Some projects needing to be completed include: Cleaning air conditioner filters, changing furnace filters, changing some light bulbs, changing out smoke detector, and exit sign batteries; up righting a fallen flagpole and pouring quick-rete, rehanging flags, leveling a small amount of dirt in yard; raking flower beds, preparing pots for Spring and planning some flowers; adding mulch to playground, installing mailbox on post and putting in ground; installing some power strips and removing extension cords, and installing some switch and socket plates; carrying some storage cabinets downstairs, hanging some large framed artwork; and a few other small jobs, as well as some light cleaning. As you know, of course, many hands make light work.
