A young Frederick A. Ross who lived at Rotherwood attended the organizational meeting of Old Kingsport Presbyterian Church in 1820. Weaver Presbyterian on Weaver Pike in Bristol has been serving both Presbyterian and Methodist congregations since 1771. Their church functions as both a Presbyterian and a Methodist church today – they belong to both Holston Presbytery and the Methodist Organization. Paperville Presbyterian founded in 1824 in Bristol is now a private residence. Arcadia Presbyterian located on Bloomingdale Pike in east Kingsport was founded in 1871 and has been a church, a Temperance Hall, and a school. These are just a few of the facts you will learn by visiting the new exhibit in our History Room.
