World Communion Sunday:

The wooden bowl and table coverings are from Costa Rica. The breads in the bowl represent various countries from around the world.

<u>Costa Rica Tortilla</u> – This Versatile homemade tortilla is the staple in many Latin America households. Made with corn flour, water and a pinch of salt and usually pressed into a disc shape with the palm of your hand and cooked in a cast iron pan. Young girls learn to make them from their mothers and grandmothers at a very early age.

Eastern Europe Rye Bread - Countries around the world have their own versions and have been around since the Middle Ages thanks to the rue's ability to grow in poor soil and through droughts.

French Baguette - One of the most well known of the French breads, not to be confused with French loaves that are wider, baguettes are oblong and thin and eaten alone or dipped in olive oil or soups.

India Naan - Most popular flat bread traditionally made with all purpose flour as well as milk or yogurt and brushed with butter.

Italy Focaccia - Rustic all-purpose bread used as sandwich bread or served as a side dish and is often heavily herbed.

Italy Ciabatta - Crusty type of Italian loaf great for sandwiches or dipping in hearty soups.

Middle Eastern Pita - Known for its pockets that form when risen and backed in a hot oven and eaten with hummus or stuffed with various fillings.
