Friends in Faith Class Begins New Series on October 8 Exploring the "Book of Confessions"

The Friends in Faith Sunday School Class will begin a new 6-week series on October 8th entitled **Exploring the "Book of Confessions."** The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) has a collection of eleven creeds and confessions in our *Book of Confessions*. These documents, from the early church to the present time, convey the richness and depth of our theological tradition. They give us rich insights on what we believe and how we can live.
