- Seeking a servant leader with vision and enthusiasm to recruit, inspire, teach and nurture both individuals and developing ensembles with pastoral care
- A humble willingness to serve with the Head of Staff, other staff, Worship Committee, etc. in a shared vision and values for developing worship and vibrant fellowship
- In the context of a genuine personal faith, a vibrant understanding of Christian Theology within the Reformed Tradition of the Presbyterian Church and its Liturgy
