

The Kingsport Music Club in March

The March Kingsport Music Club Program will be held in the Chapel of First Broad Street United Methodist Church on **Thursday, March 12**, at 1:00 p.m. The program will feature ETSU Assistant Professor Éva Polgár and her students. This program is free and open to the public.

Pianist Éva Polgár is a sought-after recitalist, concerto soloist, chamber musician, recording artist, educator, and adjudicator. She joined ETSU as an Assistant Professor in Fall of 2023 to lead the keyboard area, and to teach applied piano, piano literature, and piano ensemble courses.

Polgár holds a Master of Music in piano performance and piano pedagogy degrees from the Franz Liszt Academy of Music in Budapest and the Sibelius Academy in Helsinki. She earned her Doctor of Musical Arts degree in piano performance at the University of North Texas, specializing in contemporary music performance practice. Before joining the music faculty at East Tennessee State University, she taught piano and related courses at Azusa Pacific University, University of North Texas, and Texas Woman's University. Besides her teaching appointment, she is an elected member of the Board of Directors at the Southern California Chapter and the national organization of the American Liszt Society.
